Covid-19 Update, San Quentin State Prison

On April 7, 2020 the two week quarantine / lockdown was lifted, and prisoners here in East Block went back to what is referred to as a "modified program." Visits are still cancelled statewide, but the modified program means that prisoners here on death row will again be afforded yard three days a week.

In other news, on March 30, 2020 I filed an emergency 602 appeal with the prison administration asking that prisoners be provided masks, gloves, and cleaning supplies so that they are able to lessen their chances of catching Coronavirus from staff. I also made the request that staff be required to wear a N95 mask at all times.

In spite of the worldwide pandemic, I received notice^{on} April 7, 2020 from the appeals coordinator that my 602 appeal did not meet the criteria of an Emergency Appeal. This means that the appeal will not be fast tracked, instead, it will be stone-walled and sent to the lowest level of review.

It appears that the administration is opposed to granting any relief, so I will keep everyone informed as I exhaust my administrative remedies and prepare to take this matter to court, if need be.

I close for now, but rest assured that my updates will continue. Sending love and well wishes.

CLEARLY STATE THE SERVICE OR ITEM REQUESTED OR REASON FOR INTERVIEW.
 We are in the midst of a worldwide pandemic and staff are not wearing masks. Chow was passed out this morning and I noted that C/O Munger was without mask. Medical staff went cell to cell this morning asking to check temperatures, I noticed that neither the nurse or the escorting officer were wearing a mask. The phone is now being wheeled down the tier from cell to cell so that prisoners can make a free 15 minute phone call. I would like to utilize my pandemic related phone call, but I am first requesting that myself and other prisoners be provided with N95 masks, gloves, and bleach so that we are exercising common sense COVID-19 prevention measures. Lastly, I am asking that ALL staff members, including medical, be equipped with, and required to wear a N95 mask at all times to promote health and safety.
